During the Little Entrance, chant the Resurrectional Apolytikion. The Eisodikon (Entrance Hymn) is "O come, let us worship... save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead..." After the Little Entrance, chant these hymns in the following order:

When Thou didst submit Thyself unto death, O Thou deathless and immortal One, then Thou didst destroy hell with Thy Godly power. And when Thou didst raise the dead from beneath the earth, all the powers of Heaven did cry aloud unto Thee: O Christ, Thou giver of life, glory to Thee.

APOLYTIKION OF THE HOLY

Thou, O Christ, art our God of exceeding praise Who didst establish our holy Fathers as luminous stars upon earth, and through them didst guide us unto the true Faith, O most merciful One, glory to Thee.

FATHERS IN TONE EIGHT

Now sing the apolytikion of the patron saint or feast of the temple.

ORDINARY KONTAKION IN TONE TWO

O protection of Christians that cannot be put to shame, mediation unto the Creator most constant, O despise not the suppliant voices of those who have sinned; but be thou quick, O good one, to come unto our aid, who in faith cry unto thee: Hasten to intercession, and speed thou to make supplication, thou who dost ever protect, O Theotokos, them that honor thee.

Salute those who love us in the faith. Grace be with you all. Amen.

THE GOSPEL (For the Fourth Sunday of Luke)

The Reading from the Holy Gospel according to St. Luke. (8:5-15)

The Lord spoke this parable: "A sower went out to sow his seed; and as he sowed, some fell along the path, and was trodden under foot, and the birds of the air devoured it. And some fell on the rock; and as it grew up, it withered away, because it had no moisture. And some fell among thorns; and the thorns grew with it and choked it. And some fell into good soil and grew, and yielded a hundredfold." And when His Disciples asked Him what this parable meant, Jesus said, "To you it has been given to know the secrets of the kingdom of God; but for others they are in parables, so that seeing they may not see, and hearing they may not understand. Now the parable is this: The seed is

للكنيسة بُعدان لا بد منهما: المؤسساتي والسرّي. بهما تعيش بالروح القدس وتشهد له في العالم. بُعدها السريّ يقوّم كيانها ويؤنجل رسالتها ويطهّر مؤسساتها، وبُعدها المؤسساتي يوصل روحها ورسالتها إلى العالم وبواسطته يعطي الله عطاياه للخليقة. عندما نتكلّم عن الكنيسة المؤسسة نقصد توزُع الكنيسة على بطريركيات، فأبرشيات، فرعايا: كهنة ومؤمنين وبيوت عبادة ومؤسسات شاهدة وخادمة. نقصد بالبعد المؤسساتي الإدارة الكنسية والهيئات المسيحية من مجالس ومؤتمرات ودور عبادة ونشر ومدارس أحد وأخويات وأديرة ومراكز تبشير ومحبة ورحمة كالمياتم ودور العجزة وبيوت ذوي الاحتياجات الخاصة والجمعيات الخيرية... إلخ مع كل نشاطاتها. العجزة وبيوت ذوي الاحتياجات الخاصة والجمعيات الخيرية... النماطات الرعائية من رحلات وموائد محبة ومحاضرات ومناسبات مختلفة؛ التنظيمات القائمة، أكهنوتية كانت أم رهبانية أم علمانية...

عبر الكنيسة المؤسسة تصل عطايا المسيح لهذا العالم، ويشاهد الناس تجسيد نعمة المسيح، ويلمسون المحبة والتواضع والرأفة والرحمة... يجب أن تتجسّد الفضائل الإنجيلية في الكنيسة، وهي تتجسّد عملياً في مؤسسات هذه الكنيسة التي يفترض بها أن تكون يدى المسيح على الأرض.

أما البُعد السّري أو الداخلي أو الروحي فهو قلب المسيح في الكنيسة. إنّه الروح التي تعمل بها الكنيسة لترضى ربها أولاً. إنّه وضع الإنجيل ومتطلباته في مركز كلّ عمل

وهيئة ونشاط وشهادة. دون هذا البعد تصير الكنيسة مؤسسة من هذا العالم، تفكّر كما يفكّر هذا العالم، وتخطّط وتنفّذ وتدير وتعمل لا حسب قلب المسيح وإنجيله بل حسب فكر العالم وإبليسه. يُحفَظ البُعد السّري في قدّيسي الكنيسة وتواصلهم الدائم مع الله وسعيهم المستمر لاستلهام الروح القدس. يُحفَظ في الحياة التي تطلب المسيح أولاً وآخراً وتعي جيداً أنّه هو الألف والياء وتالياً هو المُعين والسند والمنقذ والمخلّص. ويَحفَظ البُعد السّري الكنيسة المؤسّسة من الانحراف والوقوع في فخ المؤسّساتية العالمية. إنّه يذكّرها بدعوتها الأساسية وإنجيلها وسيدها الأوحد. فلا تكون ظالمة وبطّاشة وأهوائية ومتقلّبة وتابعة وماديّة.

إذا كان ملكوت الله في داخلنا، وإذا كانت دعوة الإنجيل أن نطلب ملكوت الله أولاً وبرّه، فكم يلزم أن نركّز على البعد السّري لنكون كنيسة ينظر إليها ربها فيبتسم ويبارك!! ماذا بوسع اليدين أن تقدما إذا كان القلب فارغاً من رحمة الله؟

The Church as Institution and the Church as Spirit By His Eminence Metropolitan Saba (Isper)

His Eminence delivered this address at the meeting of the Archdiocese Board of Trustees on October 6, 2023 in Chicago, III.

The Church has two imperative dimensions: institutional and mystic. Through them, she lives by the Holy Spirit and bears witness to Him in the world. The mystic dimension corrects her structure, drives her mission and purifies her institutions. In return, the institutional dimension communicates her spirit and mission to the world, and through it, God extends His gifts to His creation.

When we speak of the Church as an institution, we mean the Church as patriarchates, dioceses, parishes: priests, faithful, houses of worship, departments, institutions that are meant to witness to Christ and serve Him. The institutional dimension also includes ecclesiastical administration such as councils, conferences, publishing presses, Sunday Schools, fellowships, monasteries, and centers of evangelism. We also mean philanthropic ministries such as orphanages, senior homes, homes for people with special needs, charities, and whatever relates to them. We also mean ecclesiastical endowments and their finances, policies, investments and operations; pastoral activities such as pilgrimages, agape meals, lectures and similar events; and organizations that are priestly, monastic or for the laity.

The gifts of Christ reach this world through the Church as an institution. People see the embodiment of Christ's grace, as they touch love, humility, compassion and mercy. Evangelical virtues must be embodied in the Church. They are practically embodied in the institutions of the Church, which are supposed to be the hands of Christ on earth.


At the same time, the mystical, inner or spiritual dimension is the heart of Christ in the Church. It is the spirit with which the Church works to satisfy her Lord first. It is the placement of the gospel and its requirements at the center of every action, body, activity, witness and institution. Without this dimension, the Church becomes an institution of this world, thinking as this world thinks — secularly — planning, executing, managing and acting not according to the heart and gospel of Christ, but according to the mind of the world and the evil one.

The saints of the Church sustained the mystical dimension and preserved it in the Church. They accomplished this through their constant communication with God and by their constant quest for inspiration by the Holy Spirit. The spiritual and mystic dimension is preserved in the life that seeks Christ first and foremost and is well aware that He is the Alpha and the Omega and therefore He is the Helper, the Supporter, the Sustainer and the Savior. He is the Giver of Life as we sing in our liturgy.

The mystical dimension protects the institutional church from deviating into the trap of worldly institutionalism. It reminds her of her essential vocation, her gospel and her only Master, lest she be unjust, cruel, passionate, volatile, subordinate and materialistic.

If the Kingdom of God is within us, and if the call of the Gospel is to seek the Kingdom of God first and foremost, how great must we focus on the mystical dimension to be a Church whose Lord looks at her and smiles and blesses! What can the hands offer if the heart is empty of God's mercy?
